14 They replied, 'Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, Jeremiah or one of the prophets.'

15 'But what about you?' he asked. 'Who do you say I am?'

16 Simon Peter answered, 'You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.'

17 Jesus replied, 'Blessed are you, Simon son of Jonah, for this was not revealed to you by flesh and blood, but by my Father in heaven. 18 And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it. 19 I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.' 20 Then he ordered his disciples not to tell anyone that he was the Messiah.

Going Deeper

Bible Notes

This week's events take place where Caesar is proclaimed to be God. For Jews, this is a repugnant, blasphemous place to go to. But Jesus comes here to ask pointedly political questions about his identity.

In this charged atmosphere, Jesus asks his disciples who they think he is. Peter shoots back, 'You are the Messiah, the Son of the living God.' In the shadow of the walls of the seat of government, this was dangerous talk; if Peter is saying that Jesus is Lord, then he is saying that Caesar is not!

Throughout history, empires have told the same story: they all celebrate power and selfinterest, and crush anyone who opposes them. But there is an alternative story to be told: one that champions forgiveness, compassion and self-sacrifice. This is the agenda loosed by Jesus and his followers. Jesus offers something different from the narrative of power and self-interest: a better story than the one told by Caesar and other earthly empires. With the confession that Jesus is the Messiah, we break free from a system that oppresses us. It is a statement of liberation. How can we proclaim afresh that message of liberation to those oppressed today?
